



Rotary Club of La Crosse After-Hours Membership Dues Contract

Annual club dues are \$140 for members. Dues are collected quarterly and do not include meeting fees. The dues cover Membership to Rotary International, a subscription to The Rotarian magazine, and club liability insurance and council on legislation.

Meeting fees are \$13 and are not included in the annual club dues. Meeting fees include food, parking, and facility. Can be paid in the form of cash or check at each meeting, unless prepaid.

\$15.00 Chartering Fee (A onetime fee for all members) Includes name badge, Rotary pin and certificate.

And....

Full-Yearly Dues/Meeting Fees \$452 (includes dues and pre-paid meeting fees).

This option is preferable for members that will be regularly attending meetings and also favorable to most employers that will be paying employee memberships on annual budgets. *Please have your name indicated on the company check!*

Yearly Dues Only \$140 (includes dues but not meeting fees).

All quarter dues are paid for the year (\$35 per quarter) but the meeting fees of \$13 need to be paid per meeting attended.

Quarterly Dues/Meeting Fees \$113 (includes dues and prepaid meeting fees).

Instead of paying all the dues/meeting fees at one time dues will be collected at the beginning of each quarter - in January, April, July, and October. Meeting fees are included in this option (2x per month).

Quarterly Dues Only \$35 (dues only)

This option allows members to pay a less initial amount at the beginning of each quarter. Members selecting this option will pay \$13 at the registration table prior to each meeting to cover the meal, parking and facility fees. This option is preferable to those unable to attend all meetings.

Dues are emailed every quarter (Jan, April, July, Oct) and payments are due net 30 days. After 30 days, a reminder for payment is emailed. After 60 day past due, another reminder is sent and this is the last warning before an email regarding termination is sent. Termination of a member may result pending a Board discussion if your dues are unpaid after 60 days. If you would like to change your payment option at any quarter, please email the club Treasurer.

If you are unable to attend meetings and events, dues are still your responsibility to be paid in full and remain in good standing with the club. Failure to do so results in termination from the club. If you plan to leave the club for a time period or resign from the club, you must submit it in writing within 30 days of leaving to the club President. Upon leaving the club, your balance must be paid in full to remain in good standing with the club and have the option to rejoin in the future.
